

## Thrombus Removal With “X-SIZER” Device

A.T., 71 YR. Chinese Male.

- 1992                    Unstable angina  
Hypertension x 15 years  
Diabetes x 2 years  
Hyperlipidaemia x 5 years  
Nonsmoker
- 1992 -                    70% left main stem & triple vessel disease  
EF 64%
- 1992-                    CABG done
- SVG to LAD
  - SVG to OM1 & OM2
  - SVG to RCA
- Sept 2000 -            Developed angina  
Left Main total occlusion  
RCA diffusely diseased  
SVG to LAD patent  
SVG to RCA, 50% lesion in the distal third  
SVG to OM1 & OM2  
Aorto ostial occlusion  
EF 25%
- Sept 2000 -            CABG done
- Free LIMA to diagonal
  - SVG to OM1 & OM2
  - SVG to PDA
  - OSVG to LAD patent
- April 2001 –           Presented with unstable angina  
Coronary Angiogram –  
Left main total occlusion  
RCA total occlusion  
SVG to LAD patent  
SVG to OM1 & OM2 patent  
Free IMA to first diagonal – large thrombus in proximal third  
EF 20%
