

1118 A non usual STEMI with Cardiogenic Shock after Cardiac Surgery

Man 75 years old

Dyspnea Class 3 NYHA

Absence of Risk Factor. Absence of angina

ECG normal

TEE showed:

Massive Aortic regurgitation (3/4)

Bicuspid valve. Aneurysm of Ascendant Aorta (48 mm)

Mitral Regurgitation (3/4)

Coronary angiogram normal

At the end of intervention: (Bentall)

Cardiogenic shock (when ECC was stopped..)

Control of the Aortic root and verification of the coronaries ostia implantation of an ECMO

Persistence of cardiogenic shock:

control angiogram show: occlusion of Left main

PCI (thrombo aspiration, Stent) and atrioseptostomie

Discussion of the mecanism (GRF Glue on the ostium or Kink of Left main..)
